What to do in Benidorm?

Benidorm is a town surrounded by mountains and with south-facing beaches. It has an exceptional climate throughout the year and enjoys the advantages of the Mediterranean coast.

Touring the city Starting at the Torrejón Square, you can walk up "Carrer dels Gats", a typical street made of cobblestones, to St. James Church, built in the 18th century. Outside the church, you will find an arch-way that leads to Señoría Square, Castelar Square and the famous viewpoint "Mirador del Castillo". The views from here, overlooking the Levante, Poniente and Mal Pas beaches, are among the most beautiful ones in Benidorm.

Continue your journey towards the harbour, where you can go on a boat trip to the island of Benidorm, Calp or Tabarca Island. Other interesting places to visit in the town are the Elche Park, Poniente Promenade and L'Aiguera Park.

Shopping There are more than 2,000 shops throughout the town, to satisfy your shopping needs, with long and flexible opening hours. There are also commercial centres, supermarkets, street markets and flea markets in Benidorm and surrounding areas.

Tapas Spain is renowned for its tapas. Benidorm offers a wide variety of tapas bars. There is a popular tapas route, that starts at Constitución Square and goes along San-

to Domingo street, Martínez Oriola street and the surrounding ones. However, it is possible to discover tapas bars almost in every nook and cranny around Benidorm.

Restaurants The wide range of restaurants to be found in Benidorm reflects universal tastes. You can enjoy local dishes such as legumes, fish or meat stews, along the famous cuisine from Alicante (based on rice cooked in "paellas" or pots known as "calderos") and also Italian, Indian, Chinese, Thai, Argentinian, Moroccan, Mexican, British, Central European and French cuisine. And besides all these, there are many fast food places, grills and excellent restaurants of creative cuisine to savour in Benidorm.

Leisure in town Benidorm is a town of leisure. There are many clubs offering different atmospheres and dance floors with different types of music, many of which open until dawn. Benidorm also offers a large variety of bars with music and live shows, dancing orchestras and a very good choice of shows and entertainment in hotels. The "Benidorm Palace" offers dinner and high quality artistic dance performance, suitable for all ages. You will have a very goog time, at "El Molino" and "Burlesque", with their musical and comic show with drag-queens.

Under the name of "Cultural Summer", many musical and cultural events of national and international relevance are organised.

Benidorm Festias The Fiestas Calendar covers the whole year. The Patron Saint's Festival starts the second weekend of November with five days of intense fun, including the celebration of the "Escenificación del Hallazgo de la Virgen del Sufragio" (Reenactment of the Finding of the Virgin of the Suffrage), a festival declared a Valencian Region Touristic Event. Other celebrations which can be enjoyed are: the "Fiesta de la Carxofa" (Festival of the Artichoke), Christmas, St. Anthony's Fiesta, Carnival. Commemoration of the Founding of the Virgin of the Suffrage, St. Joseph's Fallas, Holy Week, St. John's Bonfires, St. James' Day, Asturias' Day, Castilla La Mancha's Day, Moors and Christians and many others.

Sports Benidorm offers an amazing range of water sports. Water skiing at the Cable Ski was the first one. Kayaks can be rented at the end of the Levante Beach, from Easter throughout the summer. In the harbour, you can also find parasailing as well as boat rentals and other nautical activities. Diving lovers will also find there, a diving club suitable for amateurs and professionals.

Benidorm also has several municipal sports centres, where a wide variety of sports can be played: Sports City Guillermo Amor, Palau d'Esports L'Il·la de Benidorm as well as Antonio López Football Fields.

It is also possible to rent quads and karts, participate in off-road expeditions, go adventure sports, hiking, biking, trekking, go horse riding and play tennis, golf or bowls, among many other activities.

Theme Parks "Terra Mitica", one of the theme parks in Benidorm, offers to its visitors the opportunity to become familiar with the ancient Mediterranean civilizations: Egypt,

Greece, Rome, Iberia and the Islands. It also offers water and mechanical rides and has special rides for children.

"Mundomar" is a park of exotic and sea animals. Flamingos, turtles, penguins, parrots,... dolphins and seal shows, restaurants, picnic areas and a splendid view point, where you will spend a very enjoyable day.

"Aqualandia" is a water park with many attractions to enjoy, for children, youth and adults: waterfalls, rapids, cascades, lakes, Zig-Zag, Kamikaze and Black Hole slides, wave swimming pools... and also shows.

"Terra Natura" promotes the conservation of the endangered species. It is divided into four thematic areas (Europe, Asia, America and Pan-gaea). 1.500 animals of 200 different species can be visited in the recreation of their natural habitats, without visual barriers.

Attached to "Terra Natura" is the "Aqua Natura" park with swimming areas for all ages and more than 1.000 meters of water slides, man-made beaches and shows.

"Festilandia Park", at Mediteráneo avenue, is a leisure centre with a funfair for children.
